



Electrocochleography (ECOG) Instructions

Your doctor has scheduled you for an ECOG test. This test records cochlear (inner ear) potentials, which are used in the evaluation of Endolymphatic Hydrops.

- Please do not use make-up or lotion on your face, around your eyes, or behind your ears.
- There are no food, drink, or medication restrictions.
- To prepare you for this test, the audiologist will scrub a spot on your forehead and behind each ear.
- An adhesive electrode patch will be placed on each of the spots.
- A tiny sponge-like electrode will be carefully placed onto your eardrum.
- There may be slight discomfort associated with this procedure.
- A foam insert will be placed into your ear canal.
- You will hear a series of clicks and bursts of noise.
- No response is required on your part for this test.
- The test procedure takes approximately 15-30 minutes.
